THE CURRICULUM

We follow the XSEED curriculum which is planned as a whole, with the aim of providing a broad, balanced and relevant programme of study for all. A wide range of teaching and learning strategies are used dependent upon the age and stage of learning of the student. Information technology is integrated into the curriculum and is used to support and extend learning.

INSIDE THE CLASSROOM

We use methods that encourage and develop individual study skills, which includes experimentation and play-based methods. Tasks are also set for students as homework which can be done individually and which sometimes need the parents involvement.



OUTSIDE THE CLASSROOM

We offer many and varied extra-curricular activities in which students

can participate. Visits to places of interest such as museums, theatres, industries etc take place regularly and are an integral part of the curriculum delivery.





ASSESSMENT

A detailed report will be sent home twice a year. Parents are invited to attend Parent-Teacher Meetings (PTM) at school to discuss their child's progress. Students in early programme are assessed daily by their homeroom teacher whereas the students in primary section are assessed with separate tests and exams.

ABSENCE AND LEAVE

- It is very important that students attend school regularly and arrive on time. School gate will be closed at 9:00 A.M.
- Parents are requested to apply for leaves incase of absence and provide medical certificate if absent for more than 3 days.
- Students are strictly forbidden to leave the school premises during school hours without permission.

ADMISSIONS

- Admissions for Early Programme (EP) will be on first come first basis.
- Entrance test will be conducted from Grade 1 and above.
- There will be no refund once admission is done and full tuition fees for one academic year will be charged.
